

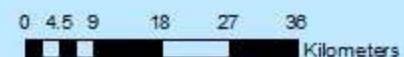
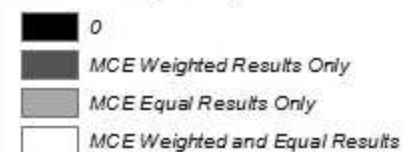

Suitable Mountain Caribou Habitat in the Hart Range

The Hart Range, in southeastern British Columbia, supports a decreasing population of Mountain Caribou. The Caribou Habitat Suitability Map was created by a Multi-Criteria Evaluation. Criteria taken into account included forestry roads, railroads, highways, land use, terrain slope and elevation, as well as biogeoclimate (BEC) zone within the study area.
